### Brief

To furnish the campus' 4,000 square metre Learning Centre including IT suite, Library, Offices and Learning rooms to be opened by the Queen.

The state of the art Campus has been furnished throughout with Eurotek's latest furniture range, agio. This includes a spacious library, IT suite, direct learning rooms and individual offices. According to Mr Solman, agio was selected for three key reasons. "The first was that it had to be practical. We wanted furniture that would work with floor services (such as cabling). The second was that we wanted something that was modern looking that wouldn't age and was robust enough to last. The third reason was price. Compared to other systems on the market, agio provided us with a very cost effective solution to our needs.

In total, Eurotek provided 137 rectangular workstations, 63 radial workstations, 31 pedestals, 25 circular meeting tables, 4 meeting room tables to accommodate between 18 and 40 people, various cupboards and cabinets, around 15 specially made storage lockers

and desk mounted screens.

One of the features of agio is the shared leg option, offering considerable cost savings. In the library, for instance, the benefit of the shared leg can be clearly seen where Eurotek produced 11 eight leg special size tables, creating additional depth and width to the table tops, without the need for additional leg supports which would be commonplace with more conventional furniture.

In the IT suite, the furniture was cabled managed using cable risers along with modesty panels and cable trays. The result, a clean, uncluttered working environment.

Two finishes from the agio range were selected; the majority was warm maple with its distinctive gull-wing front lipping, whilst Calvados was chosen in the executive office suites.

The furniture was supplied through Christchurch based Euro Office

Equipment. Sales Director David Mead said the close working relationship developed between Eurotek and Euro Office had greatly assisted the RVC in meeting its objectives for the building.

"We arranged for Clive Solman to visit Eurotek's factory to see the product," said David Mead. "Eurotek spent a considerable amount of time on space planning which was spot on and this provided the installation with the correct foundation." Clive Solman was also taken to see agio "in action" at a sixth form college nearby where the product has been used in a number of classrooms, seminar and IT suites.
